PREPARING THE LAND TO POWER THE FUTURE

BLUROC CLEARS THE WAY FOR LONG TERM SOLAR PANEL INSTALLATION IN CONNECTICUT

As a utility-scale solar project developer, CTEC knew they needed to call on someone they can trust to help prepare the land for a new solar development. So they called on BLUROC.

The project location in Connecticut covered 14 acres of land, 7 of which were completely wooded by thick forest. The BLUROC superintendent walked the land and created a comprehensive plan.

BLUROC crews brought in land clearing equipment to grind and chip all of the vegetation then haul away the remaining stumps.

With a clear field, BLUROC carved out an entranceway with a paved gravel path to serve as an access road for CTEC to install the new solar panels and service them in the future.

Since the solar field will be in use for many years, BLUROC crews seeded the land to protect the exposed soil from erosion and built detention ponds to collect and control stormwater runoff and debris.

Throughout the entire project the BLUROC superintendent not only managed the crews, but served as the direct point of contact for CTEC contractors.
